#### Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 8:05 am by Board Chair, Deborah McGarrey.

#### Welcome and Roll Call

Chair Deborah McGarrey welcomed the board and attendance was noted.

#### Presentation - Ana Hernandez, COD Work Experience Instructor
