CEO REPORT

Operational Highlights February 2024

- 1. CA Forward has paid in full.
- 2. CVEP is now working with the City of Palm Springs and the Palm Springs International Airport to transfer the leases for the client businesses at the Accelerator Campus to them. Things are going smoothly, and everyone is on the same page. The expenses have already been transitioned and the airport has completed their assessment of the condition of the campus. What is going to happen should be decided and communicated sometime between the end of March and April.
- 3. Negotiations with the Desert Healthcare District are completed, and the Board unanimously approved a contract for CVEP in the amount of \$80,000 on February 29th. We will have to outsource roughly \$35,000 for the work that is expected to be completed in about 6 months. The first \$36,000 of the contract should happen in FY 23-24 and the balance in FY 24-25. This is an opportunity for follow on work that leverages the GIS capability that CVEP established.
- 4. The amended budget for the remainder of FY 23-24 will be completed and submitted to the Executive Committee for review this week. We are also roughing in a budget for FY 24-25 that reflects the new facilities arrangements and 24-25 staff.
- 5. The City of Palm Desert and CSUSB reduced the list of furnishings that they wanted and have reduced their offer to \$10,000 which we accepted. We have been assured they will honor this.
- 6. CVEP has held two Summit debriefs with staff, board, and outside participation. Several really good ideas have been floated and we will continue the process in anticipation of crafting a more visible Summit that has multiple touch points throughout the year.
- 7. CVEP has accepted Bird's Eye Aerial Drones LLC into the Palm Springs iHub. The press release and social media posts have generated much interest, and we are looking forward to integrating them into the Coachella Valley business community.
- 8. CVEP is preparing to have a "garage sale" to liquidate things that we have accumulated over the last 10 years at the Accelerator Campus. A list of inventory for the sale will be provided prior to opening the sale to the public.
- 9. CVEP is securing sponsorships for FY 24-25 with a number of familiar investors already in the process of committing to another year.
